We've had another fantastic year of fundraising; our sincere thanks to all of you – the families, staff and friends at St Peter's School – for your absolutely amazing support! **Thank you, thank you, thank you!!!**

These funds have been spent very wisely in a number of different areas across the school, such as:

- Literacy Resources

- Ice Cream treats at the Panto

- A contribution to support the whole school Legoland trip

LOOKING FORWARD....

Next school year, FoSPs are planning to continue with the successful fundraisers that we all enjoy and include one or two new fundraising projects. We'll also continue with our Wishlists and Easyfundraising, so there are many different ways you can get involved.

This is also an ideal time, with the start of a new school year, to look at how we can make best use of the funds we raise and have a positive impact on our children's education. Many schools will find the next few years financially challenging,

as school budgets are squeezed more and more. St Peter's also faces this challenge, but we are fortunate to have a fantastic, supportive group of parents and friends and an active and full fundraising calendar.

The funds we raise over the next few years will therefore make a real difference funding resources that St Peter's may find difficult to afford from their reduced budget. With this in mind, the Friends of St Peter's, together with the school team, have been working on a 5 year plan, estimating how much we

hope to raise and identifying resources and equipment that we can contribute towards.

Specifically, for the next school year, our target is to again raise £5,000. We envisage contributing in the region of £3500 towards resources, equipment and training including:

- Active Learn packages for Maths, Grammar, Spelling and Phonics
- ParentMail
- Cornerstones lesson planning package for KS1 and KS2
- Happy Lunchtime training package for all TAs

The remainder of the funds raised will contribute towards lovely extras throughout the school year.

Your continuing support for our events and activities will be much appreciated and as you can see will really benefit all of our pupils, across the school.
