Drum Pad Music Lessons

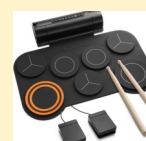

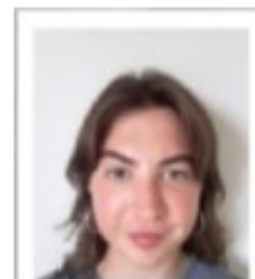
The morning will consist of a presentation, interactive discussions, and activities. Plus, tea and biscuits!

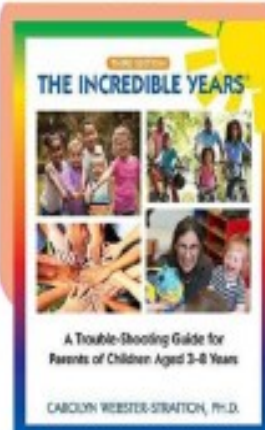
