

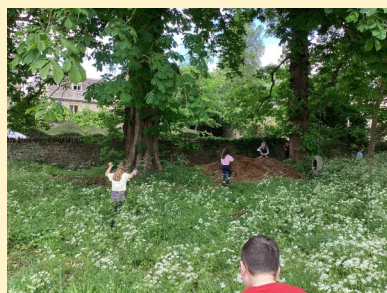
Dear Parents ,
