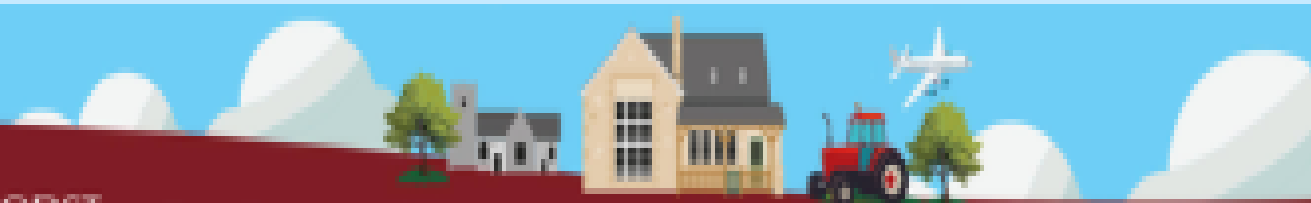
WHAT HAS MY CHILD BEEN LEARNING? THIS WEEK?
