

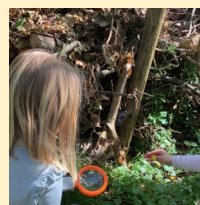


Dear Parents, this week...

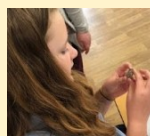
Phoenix class enjoyed their first **swimming lesson** this week. All pupils tried their best and are excitedly looking forward to lesson number two.

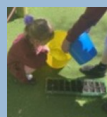

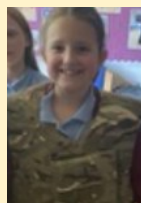
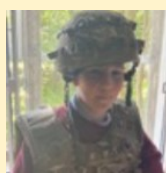
Our new **Little Musketeers** club was a huge success,

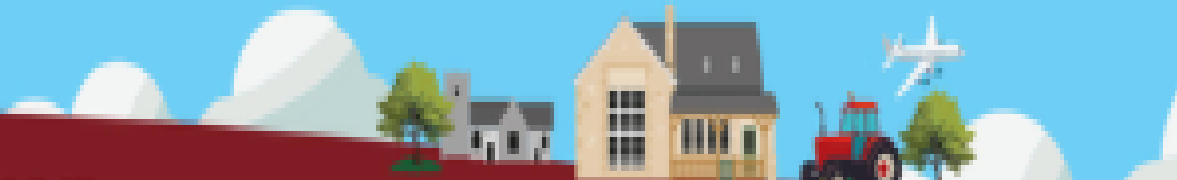


Does your employer offer any matched fundraising schemes?

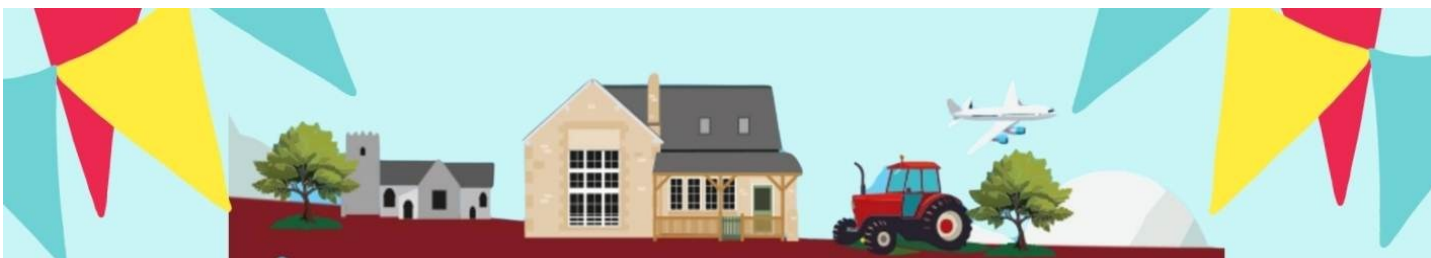
