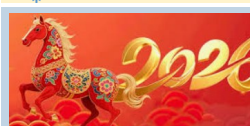
the local radio stations as well as the [Oxfordshire county Council website](#). Please also make sure your child comes to school suitable dressed for cold weather and have everything labelled! Many

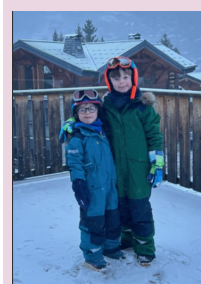
