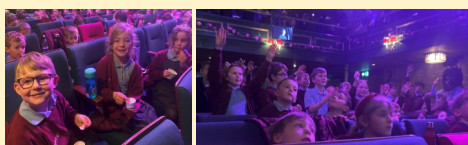
Panto
