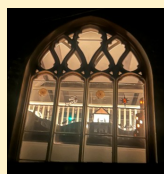


Dear families, Advent Window

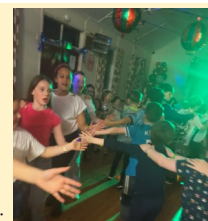

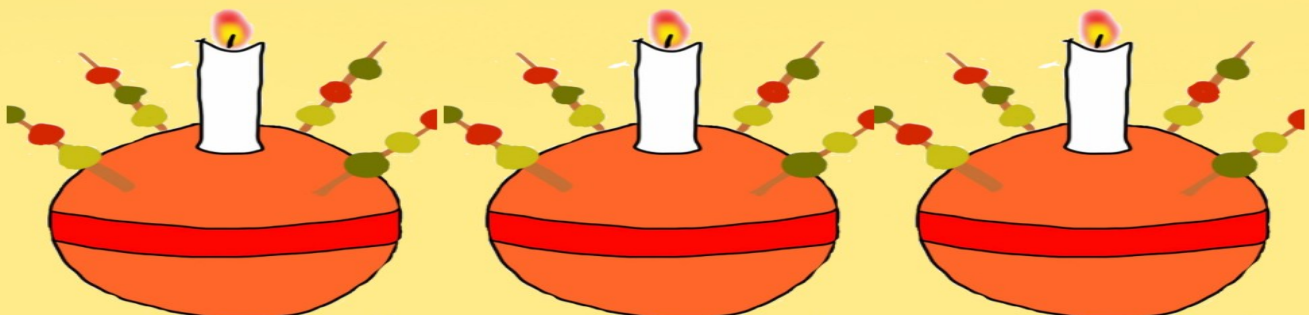
