

Uniform Policy

Purpose of the Uniform Policy

- Promote a sense of belonging and school pride
- Ensure safety, comfort, and practicality for all activities
- Make uniform options affordable and accessible
- Support the school's commitment to inclusion
- Provide good value for money

At St Peter's, we believe that all students should feel safe, comfortable, and confident in their learning environment. Our uniform policy reflects our vision of **belonging** and our aim to be **respectful and ready**, ensuring that all children—regardless of gender, culture, religion, ability, or background—are supported and celebrated. Pupils attending St Peter's are expected to be smart, well-presented, and ready for learning.

It is our policy that all pupils wear the school uniform when attending school or participating in school-organised events outside normal school hours, unless otherwise instructed.

A complete list of school uniform items, including those for PE, is attached as an appendix to this policy. Branded items can often be obtained pre-loved from the school. New branded items must be purchased from our supplier. All other uniform items may be bought from high-street retailers or as pre-loved items.

Inclusion

St Peter's welcomes pupils from all backgrounds and faith communities. Requests to wear alternative clothing on religious grounds will be considered sympathetically, and reasonable adjustments will be made where appropriate.

Parents wishing to request an exception to the uniform policy should contact the headteacher.

For pupils with SEND (Special Educational Needs and Disabilities), uniform adjustments—such as softer fabrics or alternative fits—can be arranged in consultation with the school.

Main Uniform

- St Peter's polo shirt (long or short-sleeved), or plain pale blue polo shirt without the logo
- St Peter's jumper or cardigan
- Grey trousers, shorts, or skirts
- Red checked summer dresses (optional in summer months)
- Plain grey, white, or black socks, or grey tights
- St Peter's book bag or rucksack, or a plain maroon/burgundy version

PE Uniform

- St Peter's PE T-shirt or plain pale blue T-shirt without the logo
- Plain maroon or navy shorts, skorts, leggings, or joggers
- KS2 training top (for Key Stage 2 pupils)
- Trainers for PE
- Drawstring PE bag for shoes and kit

Accessories, Extras, and Footwear

Coats

Pupils may wear a St Peter's coat or a plain maroon/navy/blue coat appropriate for the weather.

Footwear

- Plain black shoes for regular use
- Trainers for outdoor PE
- Barefoot or plimsolls for indoor PE
- Ankle boots permitted in winter
- No open-toed shoes, platform soles, or high heels

Socks must be plain (white, grey, or black)

Hair Accessories and Styles

Hair bands, ribbons, bows, or scrunchies should be:

- Plain blue, grey, or burgundy
- Free from large flowers or decorations

Jewellery and Watches

Permitted items:

- Small studs in pierced ears
- Standard wristwatches (not smartwatches)

All jewellery must be removed for PE. If studs cannot be removed, they must be taped.

Note: Staff are not permitted to remove earrings.

Additional Notes

- Makeup and nail varnish must not be worn to school
- Decorative or extreme hairstyles are not appropriate
- KS2 pupils require a swimsuit, swim hat, and optional goggles during their swimming term
- Pupils may need waterproof clothing and wellies for outdoor sessions, we will notify you when needed
- **A named water bottle is required daily**

The Role of Parents

We ask parents to:

- Ensure their child has the correct, clean, and well-maintained uniform
- Consider the weather, as pupils will be outdoors during play and PE
- Label all items to prevent loss

Lost and unclaimed uniform items may be recycled as pre-loved stock.

If a parent is unable to provide the required uniform, they are encouraged to speak with the headteacher for support.

Pupils out of uniform will be treated with understanding. The school will work with families to resolve any issues and provide necessary assistance.

Affordability

St Peter's is committed to keeping school uniform affordable. We aim to:

- **Minimise branded items**
- **Keep requirements consistent and simple**
- **Offer pre-loved uniform**
- **Provide financial assistance**, where needed, through school or local authority hardship funds
- **Limit the number of required items**

Monitoring and Review

The governing body will review this policy regularly to ensure it remains:

- Suitable for learning
- Practical and durable
- Good value for money
- Aligned with government guidance

UNIFORM LIST

	ALL YEARS Unisex sky blue polo shirt long OR short sleeved (St Peter's logo preferred but optional)
	ALL YEARS Unisex maroon cardigan OR jumper <u>with St Peter's logo.</u>
	ALL YEARS At least one option from: Grey trousers/shorts/skirt OR Red checked dress/pinafore dress At least one option from: Grey tights/ White/black/ grey socks
	ALL YEARS Pale blue round neck t-shirt (St Peter's logo preferred but optional) OPTIONAL: PE training top (pupils wear their school jumper/cardie if no training top)

	ALL YEARS At least one option from: Maroon shorts; maroon or navy skirt; jogging bottoms; leggings; tracksuit bottoms OPTIONAL: plimsolls if preferred to bare feet for indoors.
	ALL YEARS Unisex coat – maroon or blue. If not choosing St Peter's coat, please make sure coat is as plain as possible
	YR,1,2 Book bag (St Peter's logo preferred but optional)
	YEAR 3,4,5,6 Rucksack * (St Peter's logo preferred but optional)
